

Mansfield 63 Attleboro 51

Senior Maggie Danehy delivered a career-high 27 points in powering the Mansfield High girls' basketball team to a 63-51 victory over Attleboro Friday at the Albertini Gymnasium in a Hockomock League game.

Danehy scored eight of the Hornets' 18 point in the second quarter as Mansfield took a 29-23 lead. She then accounted for 11 of the Hornets' 15 third quarter points to give Mansfield a 44-35 lead going into the fourth quarter.

Sophomore Ashley Santos added 11 points for the Hornets (2-0). Kenzie Roberts paced AHS (1-2) with eight points, while Jordyn Lako and Liv McCall each had seven points.
