

Mansfield 55, Sharon 27

SHARON — Meg Hill scored a dozen first quarter points steering the Hornets in the right direction, while Mansfield hit on eight 3-point field goals overall to rout the Eagles in a Hockomock League game.

The Hornets (10-4 overall, 8-1) moved to within two victories of qualifying for the MIAA Tournament, the first opportunity coming Friday at home against North Attleboro.

Hill scored 15 of her 21 points during the first half, as Mansfield gained a 17-point lead at the stop. Hill finished with 10 rebounds and three blocked shots.

Ann Maher knocked down a trio of 3-pointers and Emily Vigeant two, the Hornets hitting five of those trifectas in the second quarter.
